

Web Page Wonders: The Birthday Place

- 1) Create a folder inside your "wonders" folder. Title it: bday
 - 2) Inside bday folder, create a folder and title it: media
 - 3) Inside bday folder, create a website with two internal pages.
 - A) index.htm
 - B) friends.htm
 - 4) Files (htm and graphics) should be stored according to the system setup in class.
 - 5) Each page should follow the sample site on the Internet. Ask questions if you are unsure as to what to do.
 - 6) friends.htm should open up into a new blank window.
 - 7) When creating the copyright line, use your first name and last initial. DO NOT USE YOUR LAST NAME.
 - 8) When creating the Contact Webmaster line, use "fkeyes@d64.org" as the email address.
 - 9) Use graphic text for your titles on both pages and use appropriate graphics for the project.
 - 10) Don't forget to title your pages. Use containing tables on each page and use other tables where needed on the pages.
 - 11) When you are done, print your pages from the Internet. Each page should print on one piece of paper. Hand them in when you are ready to be graded.
 - 12) You will be graded off site.
- EC) Create rollovers for your hobby pictures on your friends page. You will receive 5 points for the first rollover and one point for each rollover after that.
- EC) Add an automatic "date" line (javascript) on the home page following the sample. Add a comment in your html code that has the url for the site you found the information to add this date. This is worth 5 points.
- EC) Use animated gifs for your hobby graphics and you will receive one point for each of these.
