

Web Page Wonders: CD Website (Part 2)

- 1) Continue developing your "Songs" site. You will be adding three song pages and a homepage to your website.
- 2) Files (htm, graphics, audio, pdf, support, etc.) and folders should be created and stored according to the system taught in class.
- 3) File names should be no longer than eight (8) characters (excluding the dot and the extension). The names should be meaningful and anyone should be able to associate a file name and its file.
- 4) Continuity and consistency should be apparent in any website. Therefore, your formats and colors should be connected for all your pages. Include all the elements required in the previous activity for your song pages.
- 5) Additional elements that must be included:
 - Two song pages must have links to their lyrics. The lyrics pages must be PDF files that you created.
 - One song page must be linked to an audio version of the song.
 - The homepage must have an embedded song using the "soundzabout" site (volumes 3, 5 or 6).
- 6) Your homepage must follow the example homepage. The pictures will be the links. The picture should be one of the pictures used on the song page it is linked to. The picture should have no border. The songs should be in alphabetical order.

EXTRA CREDIT: Have each song page open into its own window. You must find out how to do this on your own.
- 7) All pages should be one page only in Print Preview. Print the homepage FROM THE INTERNET.
- 8) When you are done, turn in your printed copy of the homepage.
- 9) Be sure that the only files in your CD folder are the ones used for this assignment.
- 10) Copy your folder to the flash card so that it can be uploaded. After copying the folder, rename it using your first and last initial.

- 11) After your site is uploaded, you have one day to look at it at home to make sure that all elements display properly.
- 12) Make changes to your site or indicate that your site is ready for grading. Your assignment will be graded from the Internet offsite.

Grading

This activity is worth 125 points.

General Guidelines = 25 points

Homepage = 25 points

New Song Pages = 25 points each

The first extra credit link to a new window is worth 5 points and each one after that is worth one point.

To create a link to an audio file:

- 1) Select the text or image you want to use as the link to the audio file.
- 2) In the Property inspector, click the folder icon to browse for the audio file, or type the file's path and name in the Link text box.

To embed an audio file so that it plays when the page is opened, insert the green text in the code section:

"renegade.m4a" is where you would put the name of YOUR audio file.
