- 1) Create a website (at least 10 pages including your homepage) with a theme that interests you.
  
- 2) Include elements of a website that we have learned and used in class. The following elements must be included for complete credit:
  - A) Containing tables
  - B) Appropriate titles for your pages
  - B) Colored or designed backgrounds
  - C) Graphics including clip art, graphic text, and animations
  - D) Readable and purposeful text
  - E) Rollovers
  - F) Tables for text and graphic placement
  - G) Last update lines using an automatic date
  - H) Copyright protection lines
  - I) E-mail links to the web master on the home page only (fkeyes@d64.org)
  - J) Links without underlining and with different rollover colors
  - K) Internal and external links with at least one targeted window

- L) Jump menu
- M) Bottom of the page menu system

N) Extra Credit: using anchors

O) Extra Credit: a script of your choice (not automatic date)

P) Extra Credit: using a template

3) Create a "site" and use appropriate folder and file naming conventions.

4) Make sure that you use good web design techniques.

A) Plan out your pages by creating an outline.  
Drawing the layout might be helpful.

B) Gather your resources.

5) Part of your grade is how well you work independently using available resources. For example, I would not expect a question on containing tables at this point or how to set up and manage your site.

6) If you use audio, it must be limited to one piece. Our server is limited in capacity.
