

Web Page Wonders: CD Website (Part 1)

- 1) Create your site folder calling it "cd."
- 2) Create a "site" in Dreamweaver naming it "Songs."
- 3) Files (htm and graphics) and folders should be created and stored according to the system taught in class. The file name for this page should be the artist's last name or the group's name.
- 4) Create your page following the sample page.
- 5) Elements that must be included:
 - XHTML compliant
 - Containing table
 - Page title that is relevant and useful
 - Page background color
 - New link colors (link, rollover and visited)
 - Song title left aligned above a horizontal rule
 - Artist's name right aligned below the horizontal rule
 - All fonts should be sans-serif fonts except "by and the name of the artist." This should be a serif font.
 - Interesting pictures of the artist arranged in an interesting way
 - Text link to your home page (which will be created in Part 2)
 - Last update line
 - Copyright line
 - Contact webmaster link
 - No spelling errors
- 6) Extra credit elements that may be included:
 - Link to the song lyrics
 - Link to the audio version of the song

Extra credit should only be attempted if you finish the requirements early and have extra time to figure out how to do the extra credit on your own.
- 7) Print this page FROM THE INTERNET on the black and white printer. The printed page should not be more than one page; therefore, do a print preview first in case you need to make any modifications.

- 8) When you are done, turn in your printed copy of the page.
- 9) Be sure that the only graphic files in your media folder are the ones for this assignment and that the only page in your "cd" folder is the htm file created in this assignment.
- 10) Copy your folder to the flash card so that it can be uploaded. After copying the folder, rename it using your first and last initial.
- 11) After your site is uploaded, you have one day to look at it at home to make sure that all elements display properly.
- 12) Make changes to your site or indicate that your site is ready for grading. Your assignment will be graded from the Internet offsite.

Suggested Timeline

Day One: Decide on song and gather resources (graphics of artist)

Days Two and Three: Create page

Day Four: Get uploaded (if time, do extra credit)

Each extra credit link is worth 5 points.
