Goals:

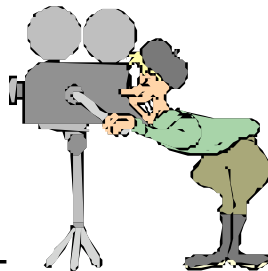
- To better understand the film production process from concept to dvd
- To learn how to film and download pictures/movies using digital still & digital video cameras
- To learn how to create and edit movies using iMovie
- To learn how to create and edit slide presentations using PowerPoint

Requirements for Completion:

- Complete a variety of skills checks in iMovie and PowerPoint
- Create a short introductory film which develops an emotion without sound and utilizes an establishing shot
- Create a scripted 30 - 45 second commercial or public service announcement (PSA)
- Create a 10 - 15 slide presentation using still photography within the presentation
- Learn how to use help resources (for problem solving and advanced learning) in order to become an independent technologist
- Act as equipment manager, if needed
- Create a music video (time permitting)
- Extra Credit: Create an original movie or slide presentation to be used in another class
